THIS EVENT AFFORDS NAVAL PERSONNEL THE OPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS RELEVANT POLICY, DOCTRINE, AND EQUIPMENT ISSUES COVERING THREE SUBJECT AREAS: DAMAGE CONTROL, FIRE FIGHTING, AND CBR-D. MAXIMUM PARTICIPATION IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED.

3. ACTION ITEMS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO RESPECTIVE TYCOMS VIA THE WEB SITE. ALL FLEET PERSONNEL ARE ENCOURAGED TO SUBMIT ACTION ITEMS REGARDLESS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE DC/FF/CBR-D WORKING GROUP. THE WEB SITE INCLUDES A LIST OF TITLES OF ALL THE OUTSTANDING ACTION ITEMS CATEGORIZED BY DC/FF/CBR-D. RECOMMEND THOSE DESIRING TO SUBMIT NEW ACTION ITEMS REVIEW THE WEB SITE TO PRECLUDE DUPLICATION. ACTION ITEM SUBMISSIONS REQUIRE ALL DATA FIELDS TO BE ANNOTATED. TYCOM POC'S WILL REVIEW AND FORWARD ACTION ITEMS TO NAVSEA/WORKING GROUP CHAIRS FOR CONSIDERATION.

4. A HIGHLIGHT OF THE DC/FF/CBR-D WORKING GROUP CONFERENCE IS THE PRESENTATION OF THE HOMER W. CARHART AWARD, HONORING THAT INDIVIDUAL SERVING IN AN AFLOAT BILLET WHOSE CONTRIBUTIONS TO DAMAGE CONTROL AND FIRE FIGHTING MERIT SPECIAL RECOGNITION BY THE SAFETY AND SURVIVABILITY COMMUNITY. NOMINATIONS FOR THIS PRESTIGIOUS AWARD SHOULD BE SENT VIA RESPECTIVE TYCOM USING THE CRITERIA OUTLINED ON THE WEB SITE.
